A Message from The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada: Royal College Examination – Application Deadlines for Assessment of Training

Registration for the certification examinations is a three-step process

Step 1

Applicants must complete and submit the application for assessment of training

http://www.royalcollege.ca/portal/page/portal/rc/common/documents/credentials/preliminary_assessment_application.pdf.

The application is not considered complete unless the assessment fee is submitted with the completed application. The deadline for the application for assessment of training is April 30th the year before you wish to take the certification examinations.

Step 2

Applicants will receive a letter regarding eligibility for the certification examinations from the Credentials Unit in December of the year the application is submitted.

Step 3

Applicants must complete and submit the examination registration forms, which are mailed with the letter of eligibility, by February 1 of the examination year. The registration is not considered complete unless the examination fee is submitted with the examination registration forms.
