UBC Clinician Investigator Program Call for Applications – 2016/2018 Academic Year

The UBC Clinician Investigator program is designed to provide a combined research and clinical training stream for residents in Clinical Specialty Programs at UBC. The aim is to encourage young physicians to pursue careers as clinician-scientists and to renew the clinical academic faculty at UBC and other Canadian Medical Schools. This aim will be accomplished by providing clinical trainees two years of protected research fellowship. The UBC CIP follows the guidelines of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) and is approved by the [RCPSC](#).

Fellowship Position Available: Cardiac Anesthesia & Perioperative Echocardiography

St. Paul's Hospital offers a 12-month adult cardiac anesthesia and echocardiography fellowship. Applicants *must* be FRCPC certified or FRCOC eligible at the time of application. **The next available start date is July 1, 2016.**

St. Paul's Hospital is a busy quaternary care urban hospital in downtown Vancouver BC, Canada. St. Paul's Hospital is the regional referral centre for complex cardiac care, including heart transplantation and mechanical circulatory support.

Approximately 900 open-heart surgeries (CABG, valve repair/replacement), including 100 adult congenital cases, are performed annually. Additionally, 185 transcatheter valve implantations, 50-60 lead extractions, 35 ECMO initiations, 15-20 heart transplants, 15-20 VADs, and 5 TEVARs are performed annually.

The 12-month fellowship includes rotations in the cardiac operating room, transesophageal echocardiography, cardiac surgical intensive care unit, and general operating rooms. Research opportunities are available and fellows are encouraged to pursue research endeavours. 4 weeks of vacation, and funding to attend a major cardiac anesthesia meeting are provided. Salary is \$84,000 CAD annually.
