The Department of Anesthesia at UHNBC provides anesthetic services to a wide range of surgical specialties like general surgery including Whipple's procedure and Esophagectomy, Urology, Orthopaedic, Plastic, ENT, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Ophthalmology, 24 hours Epidural Service and Vascular surgery. The current on call commitment is approximately 1 in 8.
